07/28/2022 Thursday 10:00 AM	Logic and Accuracy Test, by a random method of selection, a percentage of the voting machines used in the election at Early Voting and at the precincts on Election Day. Test vote-by-mail ballot tabulating equipment used in the election.
7/29/2022 Friday 10:00 AM	Initial Canvassing Board Meeting for orientation.
8/12/2022 Friday 10:00 AM	Canvass of vote-by-mail ballots.
8/19/2022 Friday 10:00 AM	
8/22/2022 Monday 10:00 AM	
8/23/2022 Tuesday Election Day 10:00 AM - Until Finished	Review of vote-by-mail ballots, and receive "unofficial" preliminary election night results at 7:00 PM until all precincts have reported.
8/25/2022 5:00 PM	Deadline to receive vote-by-mail and provisional ballot cures.
8/26/2022 9:00 AM	Canvass of provisional ballots, and review of vote-by-mail ballots. Prepare and submit 1st unofficial results to the Department of State before deadline Noon, Friday, 08/26/2022. Determine if machine recount is required in any local contest(s). If a machine recount is required in any local contest, conduct the machine recount according to the recount schedule below. In the event of a machine or manual recount, see Saturday, 08/27/2022, Noon.
8/26/2022 NOON	If no recounts, file Official Results and Conduct of Elections.
8/30/2022 9:00 AM	If no recounts are required, certify the election and official results. Submit the Conduct of Election Report. Select the contest and precinct for the post-election manual audit.
9/1/2022 10:00 AM	If no recounts are required, conduct post audit.

ONLY IN THE EVENT OF A RECOUNT, THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL MEETING DATES MAY APPLY.

DATE AND TIME	MEETING PURPOSE
8/27/2022 Saturday (if necessary for machine recount) NOON	Logic and accuracy testing for the machine recount. Test tabulating equipment to be used. Prepare and submit the 2nd unofficial results to the Department of State before deadline 3:00 PM, Sunday, 8/28/22, and determine if manual recount is needed for local contest(s) only. Secretary of State to determine and order manual recount(s) for federal, state and multi-county contest(s). If a manual recount is necessary in any local contest(s), begin and conduct the manual recount until finished. If a manual recount is necessary in any federal, state or multi-county contest(s), begin recount upon notification by the Secretary of State. The results from the manual recount are contained in the certification of the official results.
8/29/2022 Manual Recount(s) 5:00 PM	Determine from 2nd unofficial results if manual recount is needed for local contest(s) only. Secretary of State to determine and order manual recount(s) for federal, state and multi-county contest(s), if necessary. If a manual recount is necessary in any local contest(s), begin and conduct the manual recount until finished. If a manual recount is necessary in any federal, state or multi-county contest(s), begin recount upon notification by the Secretary of State. The results from the manual recount are contained in the certification of the official results.
8/30/2022 Tuesday 9:00 AM	Submit official results to the Department of State before deadline 5:00 PM, Tuesday, 08/30/22. Submit official results and certify the election. Submit Conduct of Election Report. Select the contest and precinct for the post-election manual audit.
9/1/2022 Thursday 10:00 AM	Begin post-election manual audit. The results will be announced immediately following completion of the audit. Deadline to complete the post-election manual audit is 11:59 PM the 7th day following certification of the election.
