Section 286.01105, Florida Statutes, state that if a person wishes to appeal any decision by the board, agency or commission with respect to any matter considered at a meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings and that for such purposes he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
